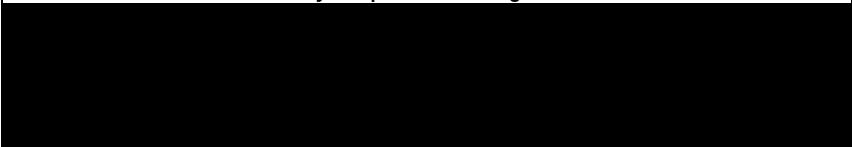

		6) <u>Software Exercise (SOE)</u> : A software exercise or problem requiring a technical solution.	
		7) <u>Take Away Paper (TAP)</u> : An assessment submitted within 24 or 48 hours (or exceptionally 72 hours) from the time of the unseen question/s publication, in which the student may use web resources, notes and/or texts. A TAP is typically used to provide a task where information must be assembled within a short time-frame. A TAP (24 hr or 48 hr) will have a notional 'work time' of up to 8 hours. Group written submission	A written report prepared collectively by a group.	<u>Group written submission (GWS)</u> : A written report prepared collectively by a group. No late submission is permitted.	
Group presentation	A presentation prepared and made collectively by a group.	<u>Group Presentation (GPN)</u> : A presentation prepared and made collectively by a group.	
Practical assessment	An assessment of a student's practical skills or competence.	1) <u>Practical Assessment (PRA)</u> : A practical assessment that may be taken under timed conditions that is observed or recorded and may require an invigilator.
